A Note From The Tax Collector

During the first week of July,
property owners in the
Township will be receiving
their school tax bills.

Additionally, **ALL** residents
of the Township over age 18
will be receiving a Per Capita
Tax bill. If you have an
escrow account for your
property taxes, the escrow
company does not pay the per
capita taxes. This has been a
matter of confusion for new
property owners and can
result in additional penalties if
not paid by 12/31.

Individuals can be exonerated
from paying the per capita
taxes for several reasons.

Some of these reasons include
low income (below \$5,000),
non-resident, duplicate bill,
deceased or active military.
An exoneration form (along
with proof) must be
completed and returned to the
tax collector. The form can
be picked up at the Township
office during the tax
collector's office hours or the

materials in these totes/bins
after the last June pick up.
You will be receiving new
totes from Apple Valley
Waste, prior to your first pick
up in July.

for the year.

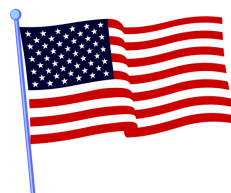
