ID showing your current ad-
dress.

freeze, chemicals, concrete
products, vegetation, shingles,
railroad ties, animal waste,
tires, fluorescent lights, items
containing mercury or lead,
batteries, barrels, tanks,
asbestos, TV's, PCs or any
other electronics.
