TOWNSHIP NEWS

Bulk Trash Days Spring dates are April 24th and 25th, 7:00-2:45 and April 26th, 7:00-11:30. Fall dates are October 9th and 10th, 7:00-2:45, and October 11th, 7:00-11:30. You must have current photo ID with you. No Tires, Hazardous Waste, Concrete Products, Items with mercury/lead, Asbestos, TV's, PC's or Electronics.

Cumberland County Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Program - residents can coordinate with the Cumberland County Recycling Center, 1001 Claremont Road, Carlisle, PA. You must make an appointment online at www.cumberlandcountypa.gov/3499 or call 717.240.6489 to make an appointment. ID will be required.

Cumberland County Record Notification System is a free service to the public, and provided through the county land records software company, Optical Storage Solutions (Landex). If you register you will get alerts by text or email if a new document has been recorded under your tax parcel number. No record notification system can determine fraud. If anyone feels they may have been the victim of deed fraud or property theft, contact the Recorder's Office to confirm deed information, and alert legal authorities and/or an attorney. Chickens are permitted according to the township ordinance ecode 360 number 350-1213 - Poultry is permitted by right in (A) Agricultural, (WC) Woodland Conservation, and (VC) Village Center Districts. With parcels less than one acre, the following regulations pertain: Hens only, must be fenced and have a chicken coop with not more than six total birds. **Please check with the township office to see what district you are zoned, and read your deed restrictions to make sure this is permitted.**

Burning Requirements ordinance ecode 360 number 129-6 The requirements for burning in the Township of any substance out of doors are as follows: A contained burning must occur a minimum of 25 feet from the nearest point of any building or structure and a minimum of 25 feet from the nearest property line. Open burning must occur a minimum of 100 feet from the nearest point of any building or structure and a minimum of 50 feet from the nearest property line. All burning must be conducted in the presence of and under the supervision of an adult person who shall be present at all times during the burning and who must completely extinguish the fire before leaving. No burning shall occur on Sundays.
