Fall Bulk Trash Days STCC will have our fall bulk trash on October 9th and 10th from 7:00 am to 2:45 pm, and Saturday October 11th, from 7:00 am to 11:30 am. Photo ID with your current address is required. Bring your items to the township building; once you pull into the township property follow the directional signs.

Bulk Trash is Limited to 3 pickup, car, or residential trailer loads. Items that will not be accepted are: * Hazardous Materials (paints, thinners, oils, antifreeze, chemicals) * Concrete Products, Vegetation, Shingles, Railroad Ties, Animal Waste * Tires, Florescent Lights * Items Containing Mercury/Lead * Batteries, Barrels/Tanks, Asbestos* TV's, PC's or Electronics.

Hazardous Waste Disposal Thursday, October 23, 2025, 11:00 am to 5:00 pm at Cumberland County Recycling Center located at 1001 Claremont Rd. Carlisle, PA. You must preregister. any questions call 717-240-6489.

Autumn is a good time to check the function of smoke alarms and change the batteries. Do not ride through piles of leaves on the road; sometimes, children think this is a good place to hide. Disconnect your garden hose from all exterior faucets. Winter will soon be here. Make sure your tires have the proper amount of tread on them and check your air pressure so you will be safe in the snow. Keep an emergency kit in your vehicle, such as jumper cables, flashlight, batteries, blanket, small tool kit, tow strap, shovel, bottled water, and protein bars. Utilize caution when driving in wintery conditions. Slow your speed and increase your following distance. Allow plow trucks to clear the roads, and do not run errands during a storm. Do not leave unattended vehicles running to warm up. This increases the potential for car theft. Keep your license and registration updated.
