Spring Bulk Trash Days STCC will have our Spring bulk trash on March 26th and 27th from 7:00 am to 2:45 pm, and Saturday, March 28th from 7:00 am to 11:30 am. Photo ID with your current address is required. Bring your items to the township building. When you pull into the township property, follow the directional signs. **Bulk Trash is Limited to 3 pickup, car, or residential trailer loads. Items that will not be accepted are:** * Hazardous Materials (paints, thinners, oils, antifreeze, chemicals) * Concrete Products, Vegetation, Shingles, Railroad Ties, Animal Waste * Tires, Fluorescent Lights * Items Containing Mercury/Lead * Batteries, Barrels/Tanks, Asbestos* TVs, PC's or Electronics.
